The freshness of the Cabernet is undeniable, I would even say perhaps a bit too emphasized. Nevertheless, a bit of air changes the game. In the mouth, the wine displays a surprising density, even roundness while having granular tannins that tighten the finish a bit. I have the impression that this wine is still searching a bit, and at the same time, it seems to be on the right path. Patience is required! I am leaning towards a potential.

Score 90-92 "Grown in biodynamics, this estate, whose terroir is made up of hydraulic and wind colluvium, produces wines that are always elegant, firm and dense which need time to fully open up. The 2021 is in this line even if it has a slight extra soul which gives it a unique olfactory signature, notes of blackcurrant, blackberry and a perfectly balanced mouth. In the context, it is an undeniable success. »

"Well known since the end of the eighteenth century, mentioned in the first Féret guide, a reference cru of the Côtes-de-Bourg appellation, acquired in 1976 by Jean-Yves Béchet, son of a wine merchant. The latter reserves 22 hectares for the flagship cuvée named Maldoror, a tribute to the poet Lautréamont. Vineyard cultivated organically and biodynamically, certified since 2010. Rich and greedy, dense and complete, this wine still deserves a little waiting. Its good black fruit complemented by spices and its solidly structured structure form a whole worthy of the vintage, underlined by a very fine and controlled woodiness. A lot of potential awaits him. The 2021 Fougas Maldoror, a blend of 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, reveals a dark, earthy bouquet with aromas of dark cherries, iris, cassis and licorice, followed by a medium-bodied, rich and dense mid-palate with carnal notes and a structuring, slightly dry finish.
